- **15-day period**: Section 169 of the *Police Act* (R.S.Q., c. P-13.1): ...[When rendering a decision] the Commissioner shall [also] inform the complainant of his right to obtain a review of the decision by submitting new facts or elements to the Commissioner, within 15 days. The Commissioner shall make his decision upon the review within 10 days and the decision is final.
